PROGRESS ON SITE

We are continuing to make good progress with the demolition of the old boiler house for the prison and will have completed these works very soon.

We have now completed construction of the new wall around the boundary of the Phase 1 area, with the retaining wall having been installed along the boundary to the rear of Penderyn Way.

We are also well underway with the removal of ground floor slabs and foundations in other areas of the site and continue to process the waste for re-use and recycling on and offsite.

UPCOMING WORK

A significant amount of the demolition has now been completed with works now focusing on clearing waste that has resulted from recent piling works.

Remaining demolitions will continue through September with the next building on site to be removed being the old sports hall.

Our dust suppression systems will continue in operation, and we will be moving our crushing area closer to the centre to of the site to further reduce disturbance.

We will be continuing to enforce quiet periods throughout the day when noisy, concrete breaking machinery is limited to 2hours on : 2hours off.
