This chimney has long been a landmark in Holloway so it's bittersweet for us all to see it go.



PROGRESS CONTINUES ON SITE

Across the wider site, we are pleased to share that our demolition works have been progressing well. This month we have continued work to remove Blocks D and 2 and have continued to process excess demolition waste to make way for removal of the old building's foundations.

UPCOMING WORK

Next month, we will continue to remove the slab and foundations of the old buildings. Wherever possible will we continue to separate out materials that can be reused on site or recycled.
