Happy New Year from the Holloway Park team. We have made lots of progress with the project since we arrived in Islington. During this time, we have been learning gradually about the needs of the borough, our neighbours and our future residents. We want to reaffirm our availability to the community to solve any queries as well as to support as much as possible any local organisations.

At Holloway Park, we are excited to be offering a 2-week **free** Green Skills – Retrofit level 2 course to Islington and Camden residents. This course is due to start on the **26th February** for 15 students.

This will be a great opportunity to find out what Retrofit technology is (such as heat pumps or solar panels) and why it is becoming so important in the construction industry. These skills will be beneficial to get sustainable jobs in the future and maybe even an opportunity to work onsite.

Progress on Site

Site remediation works are still progressing across the site, with ongoing re-use or recycling of materials where possible. The welfare/office set up on phase 1 is still ongoing and is due to complete on end of March.

Upcoming Work

The transfer of pile crush material from phase 1 to phase 2 continues. This is required to allow phase 1 works to begin in the next few months. A temporary haulage road set up will start on February 12th.
