We are pleased to say the Green Skills classes have now started at Holloway Park with young people from Islington learning about topics such as energy efficiency, health and safety and renewable technologies. 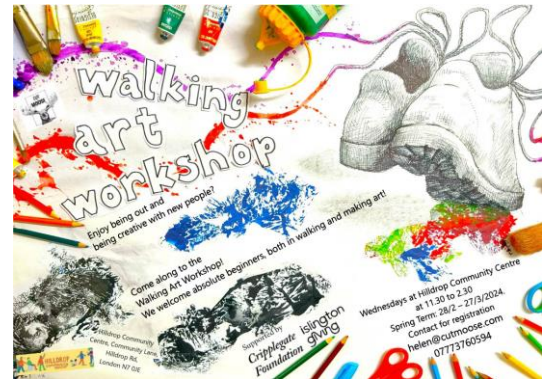
