Progress on Site

Our concrete slab to ground floor, block C, has started. We have now erected our first columns.

Our cranes TC2 and TC3 have been erected at the end of July and piles and drainage connections on block C are now completed.

Upcoming Work

- Crane TC4 (Tower Crane) will be erected at end of August.

- Piles to be cropped on blocks E1 and E2. This is done to lower the piles to the correct height.

- Central core to be commenced to block D1, D2 and D3. This is the area designed for the staircase on the blocks.
