### Reaching for the Sky at Holloway Park

We would like to introduce you to Joanne, who is working as a crane operator here with us at Holloway Park and who also happens to be a local Islington resident.

Joanne was only the second woman in Europe to work in crane operation. Even today 10 years into her career as a skilled crane operator, she told us that although now there are quite a few women, it is still unusual to be a female crane operator.

We asked her what is it like being up high in a crane? Joanne said 'It is a bit scary at first being up there, and the money is good, but the hours are long. I would encourage women to come into construction, opportunities are there especially for women, which were not there before.' She advised it is important for women who are interested to be flexible and professional in their approach to the work as they need to prove themselves to their colleagues who may not have seen a woman crane operator before.

Joanne got started by doing some research on cranes and got an apprenticeship at 42 years old. Three months at a residential training centre later, Joanne had skills to equip her to start work with 10 different construction jobs available to her, including slinger, crane supervisor, and driving dumper trucks.

Joanne was able to retrain for a career in construction through a government scheme. There are schemes and training available for those looking for a career in construction and Islington residents can contact
