Our **construction and CSCS trainings** are back from **7**th **of October**. Find out more and register your interest with <u>cecile.bouchet@peabody.org.uk</u>



Looking at artistic ideas at the Serpentine Gallery

The curation training panel have been working with Create London over the past few months learning about art and what is involved in public commissions. The curation training panel is made up of women with lived experience of the criminal justice system, interest in the arts and a connection to Islington or Holloway prison. The initiative aims to reach women who are usually underrepresented in curation.

Members of the panel were able to see how the artwork here might be relevant to Holloway Park where we are looking for artwork to acknowledge those who were in the prison that stood on the site.





Progress on Site

Block C lower ground floor concrete slab is nearly complete.

Block D works below ground floor is in progress, and the slab to block D3 is due in early September.

Upcoming Work

Tower Crane 4 (TC4) will be erected at the end of September. Works to 1st Floor concrete slab on block C and Ground Floor on block D will also start this autumn.
