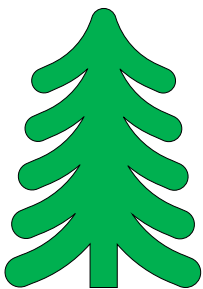

- Types of building fabric
- Key concepts of retrofitting
- Domestic retrofit materials and processes.
- Overview of installation methods for walls, roofs, floors, windows and doors.
- Health and Safety - identifying and reporting issues and risks

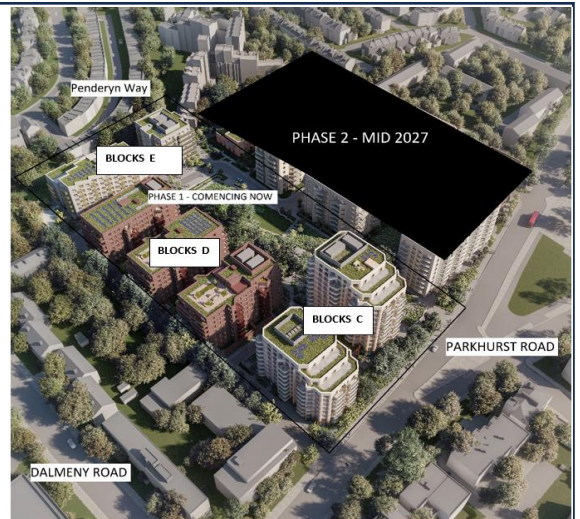


**Progress on Site**
